

AER O-38 Application Checklist

The following information must be included with an O-38 application:

- Full UWI location of the well
- Operator to ensure the well's status is reported as producing in Petrinex (e.g., pump, flow, etc.)
- Initial production with at least 30 days of oil production reported on Petrinex
Note: Please include any additional production data with the O-38 submission, in the event that it is not updated on the Petrinex system.
- Pool code/name as interpreted by the operator (only if the well is going to be part of an existing pool)
- Perforation interval, porosity top, and porosity base of the subject well
- Oil density or PVT analysis (for new pools only)
- Reservoir initial pressure and temperature for new pools
- Reservoir evaluation, including area, porosity, water saturation, shrinkage, reserves, etc.
- Any other pertaining data that would demonstrate pooling (e.g., directional survey, logs, etc.)
- Company name and contact information of applicant
