## Invitation for Feedback on Proposed New Requirements for Rock-Hosted Mineral Resource Development

On December 2, 2021, the *Mineral Resources Development Act (MRDA)* received royal assent. The *MRDA* is being implemented in two phases. In phase 1, the Government of Alberta proclaimed the parts of the *MRDA* relating to brine-hosted mineral resources in March 2023. In phase 2, proclamation of the parts of the *MRDA* relating to rock-hosted mineral resources is anticipated in 2024. The *MRDA* empowers the Alberta Energy Regulator (AER) as the life-cycle regulator with the authority to provide for the safe, efficient, orderly, and environmentally responsible development of Alberta's mineral resources.

We are currently developing the rock-hosted mineral resource regulatory framework, including rules, a directive, and other supporting documents. Liability management for rock-hosted mineral resources is also part of our regulatory framework and is currently under development. We will hold a separate public comment period for feedback concerning liability management.

We are seeking feedback on our proposed new *Draft Directive: Rock-Hosted Mineral Resource Development*. The draft directive sets out the requirements that industry must follow for rock-hosted mineral resource development and covers the entire development life cycle.

Throughout the coming year, we will prepare guidance concerning rock-hosted mineral resource development and make consequential amendments to existing directives to incorporate rock-hosted mineral resource development.
