New and Enhanced Functionality Moving to OneStop

On April 10, 2025, we will release a new replacement function in OneStop’s lands module, enabling disposition holders to replace expired public land dispositions. Replacements will be made available through a new drop-down menu item called Authorization Lifecycle, which includes amendments, renewals, and replacements functionality.

Manual 018 Public Lands Application will be updated to include disposition replacements, minor enhancements, and recent policy changes. The manual will be published on our website in May 2025.

Other Enhancements and Fixes
