

included with the facility or well application. Financial security is required for mineral licences and may be adjusted throughout the project life cycle. See Directive 090 and Manual 012.

Plant Producing >5000 m3/day

If a facility will process more than 5000 m³/day of water containing brine-hosted minerals, an approval is required under the Activities Designation Regulation (ADR). See the Guide to Content for Energy Project Applications.
