**1 DECISION**

The Energy Resources Conservation Board (ERCB/Board) notes the receipt of a confirmation of nonobjection from the intervening parties. Accordingly, a public hearing is no longer required and the Board has cancelled the hearing.

**2 APPLICATION**

ARC Resources Ltd. (ARC) applied for approval to construct and operate a pipeline for the purpose of transporting oil effluent from Legal Subdivision (LSD) 10, Section 25, Township 49, Range 6, West of the 5th Meridian, to a pipeline tie-in point at LSD 6-25-49-6W5M.

An objection to the application was filed by Harvey Van Ember, Linda Van Ember, Hal Van Ember, Crystal Campbell, Everett Van Ember, and Cindy Van Ember. The applicant engaged in the ERCB Appropriate Dispute Resolution program with the interveners on June 22, 2009.

**3 DISCUSSION**

The Board was scheduled to hold a public hearing in Drayton Valley, Alberta, on April 8, 2010, before Board Member Gordon Miller (Presiding Member), Board Member Brad McManus, Q.C., Vice-Chairman, and Acting Board Member Robert (Bob) Willard, P.Eng.

On March 16, 2010, a signed withdrawal of objection was received by the ERCB from the intervening parties.
