Proceeding 429 Goose Creek Resources Ltd.

Regulatory Appeal of the security condition requirement included in the approval of licence transfer application 1941111

Decision

[1] The Alberta Energy Regulator (AER) has discontinued the regulatory appeal because the request for the regulatory appeal has been withdrawn.

Discussion

[2] On November 2l, 2022, Raimount Energy Corp. and Goose Creek Resources Ltd. (Goose Creek) submitted a licence transfer application to the AER requesting to transfer four wells, one facility and one pipeline. The application was registered by the AER as application 1941111.

[3] On January 17, 2023, the AER approved application 194111, with a condition requiring Goose Creek to pay security in the amount of \$232,901.14, due 30 days from acceptance of the conditions.

[4] On January 17, 2023, Goose Creek submitted request for regulatory appeal 1941797 of the AER's decision to issue a conditional approval of application 1941111. The AER granted the request for the regulatory appeal on May 2, 2023.

[5] On June 5, 2023, the AER issued a Notice of Hearing.

[6] On October 4, 2023, Goose Creek withdrew the request for a regulatory appeal. The AER has therefore discontinued the regulatory appeal, as required under section 32.4 of the *Alberta Energy Regulator Rules of Practice*.

[7] Accordingly, a public hearing will not be held.
