Decision

[1] The Alberta Energy Regulator (AER) hearing panel assigned to this proceeding has cancelled the hearing, noting the filers in the hearing have withdrawn their statement of concern and that a hearing is no longer necessary. Therefore, the panel returns application 32140532 to the AER's Regulatory Applications branch for further processing.

Discussion

[2] On January 24, 2023, Ovintiv Canada ULC (Ovintiv) applied under Part 4 of the *Pipeline Act*, in accordance with *Directive 056: Energy Development Applications and Schedules*, for a pipeline within a single right-of-way.

[3] The proposed pipeline is near Wembley, Alberta. It will start in Legal Subdivision 10, Section 9, Township 71, Range 8, West of the 6th Meridian and end in Legal Subdivision 7, Section 18, Township 71, Range 8, West of the 6th Meridian. The pipeline will be 4.73 km long with a maximum outside diameter of 219.1 mm and will transport sour natural gas with a hydrogen sulphide concentration of 80 mol/kmol (8%). The application included a tie-in of wells on a multiwell pad site at Legal Subdivision 15, Section 3, Township 71, Range 8, West of the 6th Meridian.

[4] On February 27, 2023, Ed and Harriet Pollon filed statement of concern 32203 regarding the application.

[5] The AER scheduled a public hearing beginning September 10, 2024, in Grande Prairie, before hearing commissioners Parand Meysami (presiding), Harold Robinson, and Brian Zaitlin.

[6] On June 14, 2024, the AER received a withdrawal of the Pollon's statement of concern.

[7] As there is no longer any outstanding statement of concern, the panel decided it was appropriate to return the application to the AER's Regulatory Applications branch for further processing.

[8] Considering the above, the public hearing is cancelled.
