Regulatory Appeal of Decision to Approve Applications 1948251 & 1948255 and Issue Facility Licence Nos. F21911 and F53592

Decision

[1] The Alberta Energy Regulator (AER) has discontinued the regulatory appeal because the request for the regulatory appeal has been withdrawn.

Discussion

[2] Peter and Teresa von Tiesenhausen submitted a request for a regulatory appeal of the AER's decision to approve applications 1948251 and 1948255 and issue facility licence amendment F21911 and new facility licence F53592 to Veresen Midstream General Partner Inc. (Veresen). The AER granted the request for a regulatory appeal on July 12, 2024.

[3] On August 29, 2024, the AER issued a notice of hearing for this proceeding. The notice indicated that Peter and Teresa von Tiesenhausen, Veresen, and AER Regulatory Applications as parties to the appeal. The notice set a deadline for requests to participate of September 26, 2024. The AER did not receive any requests to participate.

[4] On March 26, 2025, Peter and Teresa von Tiesenhausen withdrew their request for a regulatory appeal. The AER has therefore discontinued the regulatory appeal, as required under section 32.4 of the [Alberta Energy Regulator Rules of Practice](#).

[5] Accordingly, a public hearing will not be held.
