The deadline to file concerns was at 4:00 PM on March 31, 2019; your letter was received after the deadline for filing a statement of concern (SOC). If a hearing on the application is to be held for another reason, a notice of hearing will be published.

In accordance with the *Responsible Energy Development Act* and the *AER Rules of Practice* (Rules), the AER posts public notice for all application submissions on our website, and requires SOC's be filed within the deadline set out in the notice of application. The AER has determined your statement of concern was not submitted within the time limit specified in section 5.3(a) of the Rules. Section 45 of the Rules provides that no party may file a SOC after the filing time limit has elapsed. As such, your SOC will not be considered further and will not be registered.
