Dear Alice Traill:

You are receiving this letter because you filed a statement of concern about Application No. 160636. The Alberta Energy Regulator (AER) has reviewed your statement of concern, along with the application, the applicable requirements, and other submissions or information about the application. The AER has decided that a hearing is not required under an enactment, or necessary, to consider the concerns outlined in your statement of concern.

In its review of your concerns, the AER considered the following:

- The Detailed Site Assessment (DSA) completed on August 17, 2017 shows that all
  parameters for landscape, soils, and vegetation 2010 Reclamation Criteria for
  Wellsites and Associated Facilities for Cultivated Lands (Reclamation Criteria) were
  met.
- The concerns raised about the prospect of future leaks due to historical fracking practices are speculative in nature and outside the scope of the current application.
- The The Reclamation Criteria are applied "to evaluate whether a site has met equivalent land capability." Given that the site meets the Reclamation Criteria, the AER is satisfied that the site has met equivalent land capability and that your concerns have been addressed.

Based on the above, the AER has decided not to conduct a hearing on the application. The AER has issued the applied-for Reclamation Certificate and this is your notice of that decision. A copy of the Reclamation Certificate is attached.
