Direction for Applicants Regarding Subsurface Order No. 6

Dear Counsel and Parties;

The AER issued Subsurface Order No. 6 (SSO6) on May 27, 2019. The hearing panel assigned to this matter recognizes that SSO6 is a substantive change to the regulatory framework from what was in place when the applications were submitted and the statements of concerns were filed.

As such, applications currently before the panel are no longer compliant with the regulatory framework. Applicants will need to assess how they wish to proceed with their applications. TransAlta Corporation (TransAlta) will also need to assess whether it continues to have concerns with any applications submitted under the new framework.

If parties wish to proceed with their applications, the panel sets out the following process for submitting new applications and to have them included in the proceeding, should a hearing continue to be necessary. The process allows for a hearing to resume in the most expeditious manner possible, by the hearing panel already assigned to this matter.

Process Discussion and Application Requirements

- 1. The proceeding will remain open.
- 2. Applicants must assess, under the new regulatory framework, if they wish to resubmit their applications or if they have any new applications to submit.
- 3. If so, applicants must update all application documentation [and submit new applications through the AER's normal application submission processes]. In particular survey plans and PI documentation must be updated as described below. In addition applicants must ensure that all other components of the application meet requirements such as updates to company name, mineral rights, surface agreements, proximity consents, etc.
- 4. Applicants must conduct a new Participant Involvement (PI) program to meet Directive 056 requirements.
 - a. The PI program must include notification to TransAlta as a potential party with concerns.
 - b. Should all necessary confirmations of non-objection be provided, Applicants may apply Routine as per Directive 056.

c. If confirmation of non-objection cannot be obtained the application must be submitted Nonroutine-PI.

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- 5. All applicants must provide a cover letter to request a review of the application for compliance with SSO6.
- 6. Routine applications will be reviewed and dispositioned per the normal Routine process.
- 7. Nonroutine-PI applications will be processed as follows:
 - a. Applications will be subject to the usual 30 day public notice of application period.
 - b. Authorizations will review the applications for compliance with all current requirements including SSO6.
 - c. TransAlta and other parties will have the opportunity to file a statement of concern (SOC) as per the usual process
 - d. If no SOCs are filed, Authorizations will review and disposition the applications per the usual process.
 - e. If SOCs are filed
 - i. Applicants will not be required to file a written response to TransAlta SOCs. Any required written responses would be directed by the hearing panel at a later date if necessary.
 - ii. Files which meet technical requirements and for which TransAlta has filed an SOC will be sent directly to the hearing panel.¹

The Existing Applications

The existing applications related to this proceeding (listed on page 2 of this letter) will be closed. The hearing panel considered leaving the existing applications open; however, it was determined that having Applicants and TransAlta submit the required information to the hearing panel to assess for completeness and compliance with SSO6 on a case-by-case basis is not practical and would result in lengthy delays and a disorganized hearing record containing substantial amounts of expired and redundant information.
