Dear Ms. Lambert:

The panel thanks you for your correspondence dated October 1 and 15, 2015, regarding the draft procedural direction for hearing traditional knowledge evidence in the Driftpile First Nation (Driftpile) community.

In order to ensure consistency with the panel's original intention for the community sessions, and in light of the fact that there will not be staff or other resources available at the Driftpile community session to deal with expert evidence, Andrew Fehr will not be permitted to give evidence with the elder panel on November 5, 2015. Please plan to have Mr. Fehr present his evidence and answer any questions regarding same in the course of the main hearing in Edmonton. Of course Mr. Fehr is welcome to attend the Driftpile community session as an observer.

The panel confirms that Driftpile's traditional knowledge witnesses are permitted to sit as one panel. This is reflected in the Procedural Direction that was sent out under cover of a separate letter yesterday. The panel also confirms that, if necessary, it may choose to extend the time limits set out in the procedural direction if the circumstances warrant.
