**Applications No.1831970, 1831971, and 1831972 from Husky Oil Operations  
Statement of Concern No. 29806**

Dear Mrs. Laverne Dyck:

You are receiving this letter because you filed a statement of concern about Applications No. 1831970, 1831971, and 1831972. The Alberta Energy Regulator (AER) has reviewed your statement of concern, along with the applications, the applicable requirements, and other submissions or information about the applications and has decided that a hearing is not required under an enactment or otherwise necessary to consider the concerns outlined in your statement of concern.

In its review of your concerns, the AER considered the following:

- You do not own the lands on which the project is located, and your lands are located about 0.56 km from the project.
- Regarding your concerns about odours, Husky is required to meet the requirements of *Directive 060: Upstream Petroleum Industry Flaring, Incinerating, and Venting*. Any concerns about odours during operation of the project should be reported to the AER Wainwright Field Centre.
- Your concerns about noise have been addressed by Husky's commitment to use silent shacks and hospital grade mufflers. Husky is required to meet the requirements of *Directive 038: Noise Control*, and any concerns you have about noise should be reported to the AER Wainwright Field Centre.
- Based on the above, you have not demonstrated that you may be directly and adversely affected by the applications.

The AER has issued the applied-for licences and this is your notice of that decision. Copies of the licences are enclosed. Under the *Responsible Energy Development Act* an eligible person may file a request for a regulatory appeal on an appealable decision. Eligible persons and appealable decisions are defined in section 36 of the *Responsible Energy Development Act* and section 3.1 of the *Responsible Energy Development Act General Regulation*. If you wish to file a request for regulatory appeal, you must submit your request in the form and manner and within the timeframe required by the AER.
