Dear Mr. Scott:

You are receiving this letter because you filed a statement of concern on behalf of O'Chiese First Nation (OCFN) about Applications No. 1835955 and 1835959. The Alberta Energy Regulator (AER) has reviewed your statement of concern, along with the applications, the applicable requirements, and other submissions or information about the applications and has decided that a hearing is not required under an enactment or otherwise necessary to consider the concerns outlined in your statement of concern.

In its review of OCFN's concerns, the AER considered the following:

- OCFN did not provide specific information, such as locations within or in proximity to
 the project lands where OCFN members use these lands that demonstrates how the
 proposed activities may interfere with the ability of OCFN's members to exercise
 Aboriginal and Treaty rights or how those activities may otherwise directly and adversely
 affect OCFN.
- The OCFN's reserve boundaries are located approximately 13 km west from the proposed activity.
- The concerns related to the Energy Ministerial Order 105/2014 are not applicable to this
 application which is made pursuant to an energy resources enactment, the Oil and Gas
 Conservation Act and Rules, because the Ministerial Order only applies to specified
 enactment applications and not those made under energy resource enactments.
- No Statements of Concern were filed against the two associated applications.
- OCFN has not demonstrated that it may be directly and adversely affected.

If you wish to file a request for regulatory appeal, you must submit your request in the form and manner and within the timeframe required by the AER.
