**STATEMENT OF CONCERN NO. 29988**

Dear Elsie Neumann & Henry Neumann:

You are receiving this letter because you filed a statement of concern about Applications No. 1838099, 1838111, 1838112 and 1843089. The Alberta Energy Regulator (AER) has reviewed your statement of concern, along with the application, the applicable requirements, and other submissions or information about the application and has decided that a hearing is not required under an enactment or otherwise necessary to consider the concerns outlined in your statement of concern.

In its review of your concerns, the AER considered the following:

- You do not own the lands on which the project is proposed, and you reside about 500 meters from the project.
- The notification radius for these wells is 200 meters. The AER is satisfied that once NEP became aware of your concerns, that you were provided with information regarding the project and the applications.
- Regarding your concerns about potential damage to your water well, NEP Canada ULC (NEP) has conducted water well testing on your property and has agreed to conduct post-completion testing. NEP is required to comply with all regulations regarding hydraulic fracturing and water monitoring.
- The other concerns regarding lifestyle, property value and potential land development were too general in nature to demonstrate possible impacts from the project.

Based on the above, you have not demonstrated that you may be directly and adversely affected by the applications.

The AER has issued the applied-for licences and this is your notice of that decision. Copies of the licences are enclosed. Under the *Responsible Energy Development Act* an eligible person may file a request for a regulatory appeal on an appealable decision. Eligible persons and appealable decisions are defined in section 36 of the *Responsible Energy Development Act* and section 3.1 of the *Responsible Energy Development Act General Regulation*. If you wish to file a request for regulatory appeal, you must submit your request in the form and manner and within the timeframe required by the AER.
