Dear Ms. Dahm and Mr. Plowman:

You are receiving this letter because you filed a statement of concern about the subject application. The Alberta Energy Regulator (AER) has reviewed your statement of concern, along with the application, the applicable requirements, and other submissions or information about the application and has decided that a hearing is not required under an enactment or otherwise necessary to consider the concerns outlined in your statement of concern.

In its review of your concerns, the AER considered the following:

- This is an application to add 0.87 km of new pipeline to an existing pipeline.
- There will be no venting associated with this project.
- Ms. Dahm's residence is located about 26 km northwest from the proposed pipeline.
- Mr. Plowman's residence is located about 27 km northwest from the proposed pipeline.
- Regarding your concern about wetlands, the pipeline is located on Crown land, and the potential impacts on water bodies would have been assessed at the time of the original Public Land Use application process.
- You have not provided information that demonstrates that you may use lands or other natural resources in the project area or other locations that may be affected by the project, or that the kinds of impacts you are concerned with may result from the application.

- The AER is satisfied that Baytex has met all consultation and notification requirements of Directive 056 that apply to you in relation to the application.

Based on the above, you have not demonstrated that you may be directly and adversely affected by the application for the pipeline licence. The AER has issued the applied-for licence and this is your notice of that decision. A copy of the licence is attached. Under the *Responsible Energy Development Act* an eligible person may file a request for a regulatory appeal on an appealable decision. Eligible persons and appealable decisions are defined in section 36 of the *Responsible Energy Development Act* and section 3.1 of the *Responsible Development Act General Regulation*. If you wish to file a request for regulatory appeal, you must submit your request in the form and manner and within the timeframe required by the AER.
