**STATEMENT OF CONCERN NO. 30290**

Dear Ms. Bishop:

You are receiving this letter because you filed a statement of concern on behalf of 35 landowners about Application No. 1856542. The Alberta Energy Regulator (AER) has reviewed your statement of concern, along with the application, the applicable requirements, and other submissions or information about the application and has decided that a hearing is not required under an enactment or otherwise necessary to consider the concerns outlined in your statement of concern.

In its review of your concerns, the AER considered the following:

- None of the 35 landowners own lands on which the project is proposed, nor are they within the 200 m required notification radius.
- 7 landowners own, and 4 of those 7 reside on, the lands within the 2.6 km Emergency Planning Zone (EPZ) of the project.
- The 7 landowners that own lands or reside within the 2.6 km project EPZ are also within the portion of the EPZ that overlaps the already approved Fox Creek to Namao Pipeline (F2N) EPZ at the tie in points. No new EPZ is imposed on their lands.
- The concerns regarding the EPZ were already addressed during the Fox Creek to Namao Pipeline hearing, which resulted in AER Decision 2016 ABAER 004, released on April 21, 2016.

- It does not appear that the 35 landowners may be directly and adversely affected by the proposed pipeline, setbacks, or EPZ.
- The AER completed the technical review of the application and found the application to be in compliance with applicable standards.

If you wish to file a request for regulatory appeal, you must submit your request in the form and manner and within the timeframe required by the AER.
