STATEMENT OF CONCERN NO. 30667

Dear Mr. Cowles:

You are receiving this letter because you filed a statement of concern about Application No. 1884747. The Alberta Energy Regulator (AER) has reviewed your statement of concern, along with the application, the applicable requirements, and other submissions or information about the application. The AER has decided that a hearing is not required under an enactment, or necessary, to consider the concerns outlined in your statement of concern.

In its review of your concerns, the AER considered the following:

- You do not own the property on which the project is proposed, however, the
 project is proposed for a location that is within your trapping area under TPA No.
 1345.
- You do not reside within your trapping area but you do have a trapper's cabin in NW 1-59-2 W6M, which is approximately 20 kilometres south and east of the proposed plant.
- A trapping permit grants you the exclusive right to trap fur bearing animals on TPA lands, but it does not grant you exclusive rights to use the lands.
- Your concerns regarding the impact on wildlife and the environment are general in nature. In addition, you do not identify a specific location that will or may be affected by the proposed plant, rather, you state that the increased number of oil and gas facilities and greater intensity of land and road use by industry in the area negatively impacts your harvesting, trapping trails, and the value of your trapline.

- The proposed plant will be located adjacent to the existing roadway and no new roads will be needed. CSV Midstream Solutions Corp. is required to meet all environmental and regulatory guidelines.
- Your concerns about compensation are outside the AER's jurisdiction. To the
 extent that you have a claim for loss of trapping assets, that should be addressed
 by the Alberta Trappers' Compensation Board.

Based on the above, you have not demonstrated that you may be directly and adversely affected by approval of the application. The AER has issued the applied-for licence and this is your notice of that decision. A copy of the licence is attached. Under the *Responsible Energy Development Act* an eligible person may file a request for a regulatory appeal on an appealable decision. Eligible persons and appealable decisions are defined in section 36 of the *Responsible Energy Development Act* and section 3.1 of the *Responsible Energy Development Act General Regulation*. If you wish to file a request for regulatory appeal, you must submit your request in the form and manner and within the timeframe required by the AER.
