KEYERA ENERGY LTD. APPLICATIONS NO. 1894694 and 1896773 STATEMENT OF CONCERN NO. 30829

Dear William L. McElhanney:

You are receiving this letter because you filed a statement of concern on behalf of NPS Farms Ltd. about Applications No. 1894694 and 1896773 (previously 1894695). The Alberta Energy Regulator (AER) has reviewed your statement of concern, along with the applications, the applicable requirements, and other submissions or information about the applications. The AER has decided that a hearing is not required under an enactment, or necessary, to consider the concerns outlined in your statement of concern.

In its review of your concerns, the AER considered the following:

- None of the applications require ground disturbance on NPS Farms Ltd.'s owned lands in the SE 27-53-23W4M or SE 35-53-23W4M.
- As there will be no new ground disturbance, attracting new pests and/or diseases
  to NPS Farms Ltd.'s lands as a result of amending the purpose of these lines is
  not expected. Further, the nominal operating temperature of the pipelines,
  combined with the depth of cover on these lines, is not expected to change any of
  the environmental conditions already associated with the existing lines.

Should Keyera Energy Ltd. need to do any ground disturbance in the future, for emergency response purposes or otherwise, the AER has conditioned Licence No. 59565, Lines 001 and 002, which fall on NPS Farms Ltd.'s owned lands.

Based on the above, it does not appear that you may be directly and adversely affected by the applications, and your concerns have been addressed to the AER's satisfaction. The AER has issued the applied-for licences, and this is your notice of that decision. Copies of the licences are attached. Under the *Responsible Energy Development Act* an eligible person may file a request for a regulatory appeal on an appealable decision. Eligible persons and appealable decisions are defined in section 36 of the *Responsible Energy Development Act General Regulation*. If you wish to file a request for regulatory appeal, you must submit your request in the form and manner and within the timeframe required by the AER.
