**Re: Application No. 1894935 from SemCAMS ULC (Application)  
Statement of Concern Tracking No. 30934 dated November 29, 2017(SOC)**

This letter is further my letter dated December 18, 2017 and review by the Alberta Energy Regulator (AER) of additional information provided by yourselves and SemCAMS ULC (SemCAMS) subsequent to that correspondence.

As per section 42 of the *Responsible Energy Development Act*, it is in the sole discretion of the AER to reconsider its decision not to accept the SOC, which was submitted to the AER after the deadline specified in the AER's notice of the Application.

The AER notes the following additional information obtained subsequent to its decision not to accept the SOC:

- The proposed location of the access road in the Application differs from the location of the access road in the project application information package you received from SemCAMS in the fall of 2017; and
- SemCAMS has been unable to confirm your non-objection to the Application, which was required in this situation as per AER requirements.

In light of the extraordinary facts noted above, the AER is willing to reconsider its decision not to accept the SOC.

Please resubmit an updated statement of concern relating to the Application immediately, following which the AER will review and process same as per our current procedures.
