Dear Sir:

You are receiving this letter because you filed a statement of concern about Application No.1900573. The Alberta Energy Regulator (AER) has reviewed your statement of concern, along with the application, the applicable requirements, and other submissions or information about the application. The AER has decided that a hearing is not required under an enactment, or necessary, to consider the concerns outlined in your statement of concern.

In its review of your concerns, the AER considered the following:

- You do not own the property on which the project is proposed, and your residence is approximately 0.31km from the wellsite location.
- NEP is required to meet all environmental and regulatory guidelines and requirements.
- Your concerns about the impact on your water well and property value are general in nature, and there is insufficient information to determine that they may be negatively affected.
- The objections raised in your statement of concern (SOC) have been addressed to staff's satisfaction.

Based on the above, the AER has decided not to conduct a hearing on the application. The AER has issued the applied-for licence and this is your notice of that decision. A copy of the licence is attached.

Under the *Responsible Energy Development Act* an eligible person may file a request for a regulatory appeal on an appealable decision. Eligible persons and appealable decisions

are defined in section 36 of the *Responsible Energy Development Act* and section 3.1 of the *Responsible Energy Development Act General Regulation*. If you wish to file a request for regulatory appeal, you must submit your request in the form and manner and within the timeframe required by the AER.
