Dear Mr. Terrance Jones:

You are receiving this letter because you filed a statement of concern about Applications No. 1905127, 1907186, 1907187 and 1905124. The Alberta Energy Regulator (AER) has reviewed your statement of concerns, along with the applications, the applicable requirements, and other submissions or information about the applications. The AER has decided that a hearing is not required under an enactment, or necessary, to consider the concerns outlined in your statement of concern.

In its review of your concerns, the AER considered the following:

- You do not own the land on which the projects are proposed.
- Noise requirements comply with AER *Directive 038*.
- County road allowance concerns are outside of AER jurisdiction.
- The AER acknowledges concerns regarding future well applications. As per *Directive 056*, Devon is required to include the SOC filers in its participant involvement notification program for any future infrastructure applications in the area, and to notify them when those applications are submitted.
- Devon is required to meet all environmental and regulatory guidelines and requirements.

Based on the above, you have not demonstrated that you may be directly and adversely affected by approval of the applications or that the AER should hold a hearing before making its decision on the application. The AER has issued the applied-for licences and this is your notice of that decision. Copies of the licences are attached. Under the

Responsible Energy Development Act an eligible person may file a request for a regulatory appeal on an appealable decision. Eligible persons and appealable decisions are defined in section 36 of the Responsible Energy Development Act and section 3.1 of the Responsible Energy Development Act General Regulation. If you wish to file a request for regulatory appeal, you must submit your request in the form and manner and within the timeframe required by the AER.
