**STATEMENT OF CONCERN NO. 31030**

Dear Jaret Sprott:

You are receiving this letter because you filed a statement of concern about Application No. 1906705. The Alberta Energy Regulator (AER) has reviewed your statement of concern, along with the application, the applicable requirements, and other submissions or information about the application. The AER has decided that a hearing is not required under an enactment, or necessary, to consider the concerns outlined in your statement of concern.

In its review of your concerns, the AER considered the following:

- Pembina Gas Services Ltd. (Pembina) does not hold the surface or subsurface rights at the proposed well location.
- Pembina's concerns are based on future injection and disposal activities, which are beyond the scope of the current application. Although the proposed well contemplates injection for disposal purposes, additional applications under *Directive 051: Injection and Disposal Wells – Well Classifications, Completions, Logging, and Testing* and *Directive 065: Resources Applications for Oil and Gas Reservoirs* will be required to authorize these activities.
- Pembina will have the opportunity to express its concerns regarding disposal once the appropriate applications have been received.

Based on the above, Pembina has not demonstrated that they may be directly and adversely affected by approval of the application. The AER has issued the applied-for licence and this is your notice of that decision. A copy of the licence is attached. Under the *Responsible Energy Development Act* an eligible person may file a request for a regulatory appeal on an appealable decision. Eligible persons and appealable decisions

are defined in section 36 of the *Responsible Energy Development Act* and section 3.1 of the *Responsible Energy Development Act General Regulation*. If you wish to file a request for regulatory appeal, you must submit your request in the form and manner and within the timeframe required by the AER.
