**STATEMENT OF CONCERN NO. 31025**

Dear Glen Nevokshonoff:

You are receiving this letter because you filed a statement of concern on behalf of Seven Generations Energy Ltd. (Seven Generations) about Application No. 1906705. The Alberta Energy Regulator (AER) has reviewed Seven Generations' statement of concern, along with the application, the applicable requirements, and other submissions or information about the application. The AER has decided that a hearing is not required under an enactment, or necessary, to consider the concerns outlined in Seven Generations' statement of concern.

In its review of Seven Generations' concerns, the AER considered the following:

- Seven Generations does not hold the surface or subsurface rights at the proposed well location.
- Seven Generations' concerns are based on future injection and disposal activities, which are beyond the scope of the current application. Although the proposed well contemplates injection for disposal purposes, additional applications under *Directive 051: Injection and Disposal Wells – Well Classifications, Completions, Logging, and Testing* and *Directive 065: Resources Applications for Oil and Gas Reservoirs* will be required to authorize these activities.
- Seven Generations will have the opportunity to express its concerns regarding disposal once the appropriate applications have been received.

Based on the above, Seven Generations has not demonstrated that it may be directly and adversely affected by approval of the application. The AER has issued the applied-for licence and this is Seven Generations' notice of that decision. A copy of the licence is

attached. Under the *Responsible Energy Development Act* an eligible person may file a request for a regulatory appeal on an appealable decision. Eligible persons and appealable decisions are defined in section 36 of the *Responsible Energy Development Act* and section 3.1 of the *Responsible Energy Development Act General Regulation*. If Seven Generations wishes to file a request for regulatory appeal, it must submit its request in the form and manner and within the timeframe required by the AER.
