On behalf of the Alberta Energy Regulator (AER) I acknowledge receipt of the AER's Oil and Gas North West's (OGNW) correspondence dated January 2, 2019. OGNW advises that it and Longshore Resources Ltd. (Longshore) have agreed to a resolution agreement (Agreement) that resolves the concerns of Longshore. The Agreement requires the revocation of the OGNW's decision dated February 12, 2018 (Decision) for which Longshore sought regulatory appeal so that Longshore's application for Licence of Occupation 180013 can continue to be processed.

On September 13, 2018 the AER determined that Longshore was eligible to request a regulatory appeal and approved the request for a regulatory appeal. I note that the regulatory appeal has not been dismissed. As the concerns of Longshore have been resolved through the Agreement, there is no requirement to hold a hearing into this regulatory appeal. I also note that the AER decision maker of the appealable decision is a party to the Agreement.

Therefore, pursuant to section 41(2) of *REDA*, the appealable decision is revoked and the application for Licence of Occupation 180013 is reinstated for continued processing and determination by the OGNW as per its normal process.
