Dear Wayne & Brenda Clark:

You are receiving this letter because you filed a statement of concern about Applications No. **1907419, 1907421 & 197422**. The Alberta Energy Regulator (AER) has reviewed your statement of concern, along with the applications, the applicable requirements, and other submissions or information about the applications. The AER has decided that a hearing is not required under an enactment, or necessary, to consider the concerns outlined in your statement of concern.

In its review of your concerns, the AER considered the following:

- Regarding your concerns about noise and traffic, substantial noise and traffic is only during drilling and completion. Production and operations will be during daytime hours only. The pump jacks will be electric. Bonterra states they will restrict traffic to a maximum of 60 km per hour and will monitor at daily tail gate meetings. Traffic and roads are under the jurisdiction of the county.
- Bonterra is required to be compliant with *Directive038; Noise Control*.
- Bonterra has committed to testing the water wells before and after drilling with results to be verified by an independent and accredited lab.
- Bonterra has committed to notifying you prior to flaring.
- Bonterra has agreed to move the access road.
- Bonterra has committed to weed and dust control.
- Contact your local AER Draton Valley Field Centre at 780-542-5182 or via email at DratonValley.FieldCentre@er.ca with any outstanding concerns related to the existing oil and gas infrastructure.

Based on the above, you have not demonstrated that you may be directly and adversely affected by approval of the application or that the AER should hold a hearing before making its decision on the application.

The AER has issued the applied-for licences and this is your notice of that decision. Copies of the licences are attached. Under the *Responsible Energy Development Act* an eligible person may file a request for a regulatory appeal on an appealable decision. Eligible persons and appealable decisions are defined in section 36 of the *Responsible Energy Development Act* and section 3.1 of the *Responsible Energy Development Act General Regulation*. If you wish to file a request for regulatory appeal, you must submit your request in the form and manner and within the timeframe required by the AER.
