STATEMENT OF CONCERN NO. 31130

Dear Jaimelynn MacPherson:

You are receiving this letter because you filed a statement of concern about Application No. **1907837**. The Alberta Energy Regulator (AER) has reviewed your statement of concern, along with the application, the applicable requirements, and other submissions or information about the application. The AER has decided that a hearing is not required under an enactment, or necessary, to consider the concerns outlined in your statement of concern.

In its review of your concerns, the AER considered the following:

- Your lands and residence are located within 0.5 km personal consultation radius to the west of the proposed project. You do not own the land on which the project is proposed.
- Your concerns about noise, seismicity and flaring are related to previous drilling activity rather than specific to the proposed multiwell battery.
- Bonavista provided clarification and response to your concerns with odors and noise by stating that the proposed facility will not include any odor generating process or any noise generating equipment. Bonavista will adhere to the AER *Directive 38: Noise Control* for noise levels.
- Bonavista provided responses to your concerns to the satisfaction of the AER.

Based on the above, you have not demonstrated that you may be directly and adversely affected by approval of the application or that the AER should hold a hearing before

making its decision on the application. The AER has issued the applied-for licence and this is your notice of that decision. A copy of the licence is attached. Under the *Responsible Energy Development Act* an eligible person may file a request for a regulatory appeal on an appealable decision. Eligible persons and appealable decisions are defined in section 36 of the *Responsible Energy Development Act* and section 3.1 of the *Responsible Energy Development Act General Regulation*. If you wish to file a request for regulatory appeal, you must submit your request in the form and manner and within the timeframe required by the AER.
