The Alberta Energy Regulator (AER) acknowledges the receipt of your Statement of Concern dated June 27, 2018 and subsequent information August 20, 2018, outlining your concerns regarding the subject application. Having considered your concerns, the AER notes the following:

- You have not demonstrated how you may be directly and adversely affected by this application.
- You do not own the lands on which the proposed wells will be located.
- Your concerns about consultation are based on the argument that the community as a whole needs more consultation. Such concerns do not demonstrate a direct effect on you. Further, the completeness of consultation is a matter between the AER and the applicant.
- Most of your concerns are general in nature or unrelated to this application.

Given the above, the AER has decided to exercise its discretion with respect to your statement of concern, in accordance with *Section 6.2 (1) (a) Non-consideration of statement of concern* of the *AER Rules of Practice*. Accordingly, the AER has decided to disregard your statement of concern.
