Dear Sir and Mesdames:

On March 26, 2020, the Alberta Energy Regulator (AER) panel of hearing commissioners for the above noted proceeding (the panel) received a request for adjournment of the proceeding by Shell Canada Limited pursuant to section 44 of the AER's *Rules of Practice*. The panel offered Mr. Judd and AER Regulatory Applications the opportunity to comment on the request by noon on March 31, 2020. The panel notes that Mr. Judd does not take issue with the adjournment request and a response was not received from the AER's Regulatory Applications.

Given the circumstances stated in its letter, including the ongoing review by the AER of Shell's application for approval to transfer the relevant license, the panel has decided to grant Shell's request for an adjournment, including the confirmation of participation in the hearing deadline, until August 31, 2020. Shell Canada Limited must provide a written update, which may include a further request for adjournment, to [hearing.services@er.ca](mailto:hearing.services@er.ca) on the status of its transfer of licence PL23800-99 application on

or before August 31, 2020. The AER must be given two weeks-notice of any plan to implement construction of the pipeline.
