Dear Sir/Madam:

You are receiving this letter because you filed a statement of concern regarding application no. 1925576. The Alberta Energy Regulator (AER) has reviewed your statement of concern, along with the company's application, and all applicable requirements and other submissions or information about the application. The AER has decided that a hearing is not required to consider the concerns outlined in your statement of concern.

In our review of your concerns, we considered the following:

- You have not provided information to show that you are directly and adversely effected by the proposed project.
- The concerns regarding reclamation are outside the scope of the current application. Yangarra is required to follow *2010 Reclamation Criteria for Wellsites and Associated Facilities for Cultivated Lands*, as such; you will have the ability to submit a statement of concern at that time the reclamation certificate application is submitted.
- The stated concern regarding dust and road use are outside the AER jurisdiction, and should be directed to Alberta Transportation.
- The concerns regarding compensation are outside the AER jurisdiction, and should be directed to the Surface Rights Board.

Based on the above, the AER has concluded that it is not necessary to hold a hearing before making a decision on the application. The AER has issued the applied-for licence and this is your notice of that decision. A copy of the licence is enclosed.

All AER- regulated parties must comply not only with the conditions of their authorizations, but with all of the AER's regulatory requirements. To ensure industry compliance the AER has developed its *Integrated Compliance Assurance Framework*, which embodies the three main components of all effective compliance assurance programs, those being education, prevention, and enforcement.
