Dear Suzanne Smith,

You are receiving this letter because you filed a statement of concern (SOC) on behalf of Terrence and Myrna Campbell (the Campbells) about Application No. 1934411. The Alberta Energy Regulator (AER) has reviewed your SOC, along with the application, and all applicable requirements and other submissions or information about the application. The AER has decided that a hearing is not required to consider the concerns outlined in your SOC.

In our review of your concerns, we considered the following:

- The proposed facility is not located on the Campbells lands and is approximately 700m from their residence.
- The concerns regarding enjoyment of property are general in nature and there is insufficient evidence to identify a direct and adverse impact as a result of the proposed project.

Based on the above, the AER has concluded that it is not necessary to hold a hearing before making a decision on the application. The AER has issued the applied-for licence and this is your notice of that decision. A copy of the licence is attached.

All AER-regulated parties must comply not only with the conditions of their authorizations, but with all of the AER's regulatory requirements. To ensure industry compliance the AER has developed its

*Integrated Compliance Assurance Framework*, which embodies the three main components of all effective compliance assurance programs, those being education, prevention, and enforcement. You may file a regulatory appeal on the AER's decision to issue the licence if you meet the criteria within section 36 of the *Responsible Energy Development Act*.
