Dear Bernard Chamber and Nora Chamber:

You are receiving this letter because you filed a statement of concern about Application No. 937427. The Alberta Energy Regulator (AER) has reviewed your statement of concern, along with the company's application, and all applicable requirements and other submissions or information about the application(s). The AER has decided that a hearing is not required to consider the concerns outlined in your statement of concern.

In our review of your concerns, we considered the following:

- It is our understanding that your concern in relation to the package from Paramount Resources Ltd. stating, in error, that topsoil had been added to the lease has been addressed to your satisfaction.
- Your concerns related to the remaining pipeline located south of the wellsite relates to a matter beyond the scope of the application for a reclamation certificate.

Based on the above, the AER has concluded that it is not necessary to hold a hearing before making a decision on the application(s). The AER has issued the applied-for reclamation certificate and this is your notice of that decision. A copy of the reclamation certificate is attached.

You may file a regulatory appeal on the AER's decision to issue the reclamation certificate if you meet the criteria within section 36 of the *Responsible Energy Development Act*. Filing instructions and forms are on our website under Regulatory Appeal Process.
