Thank you for your correspondence dated July 31, 2019, in which you outlined concerns about the subject application. Your concerns were received after the deadline for filing a statement of concern (SOC) for a *Directive 067* subject application, as such it will not be considered.

The Alberta Energy Regulator (AER) currently does not have any applications related to the potential license transfer from Shell to Pieridae Alberta Production Limited, if they do apply, a notice of the applications will be published on our website <a href="www.aer.ca">www.aer.ca</a>. Once the notice is posted, a new statement of concern can be submitted.

In accordance with the *Responsible Energy Development Act* and the *AER Rules of Practice* (Rules), the AER posts public notice for all application submissions on our website, and requires SOCs be filed within the deadline set out in the notice of application. The AER has determined your statement of concern was not submitted within the time limit specified in section 5.3(a) of the Rules. Section 45 of the Rules provides that no party may file a SOC after the filing time limit has elapsed. As such, your SOC will not be considered further and will not be registered.
