<b>Noncompliance fees</b>	Volumetric deficiency invoice is sent electronically to Ministry Invoices and Statements, accessible through the Petrinex menu.	Companies are required to correct the noncompliance by the next AER volumetric deadline or request a review of the volumetric deficiency from the Production Data Services team within <b>15 calendar days</b> of the AER invoice date. Failure to correct the noncompliance or request a review of the volumetric deficiency will result in the company being issued a Notice of Noncompliance.	30 days
<b>Notice of Noncompliance</b>	A letter is sent to the company at the VP level advising of the deadline for corrections. In addition to correcting the error, the company may also be required to provide a written explanation addressing the failure to respond and detailing steps to prevent future occurrences.	If the noncompliance is not corrected and the company is not actively working with the AER by the next AER volumetric deadline, the AER may take additional action, such as <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• partially or fully suspending operations</li> <li>• suspending or cancelling the permit, licence, or approval</li> <li>• issuing an order (miscellaneous, closure, or abandonment)</li> <li>• applying refer status: focused or global</li> </ul>	30 days
