

Application Buttons

Login	Once you have entered your username and password, click the login button to log into OneStop.
^	Click the Home button anywhere within OneStop to return directly to the landing page.
Initiate ▼ New Application	Click the Initiate drop down arrow to begin a new pipeline application.
Construct → eTour Submission	Future Functionality Click the Construct drop down arrow to electronically enter and submit a Tour report.
Operate ▼ Emissions Reporting Licence Amendment	Click the Operate drop down arrow to create licence amendment applications. Future Functionality

	Click Emissions Reporting to enter methane reporting data.
Close → Reclamation	Click the Close drop down arrow and select Reclamation to submit an application for a reclamation certificate.
Welcome, Logout)	Click the Logout hyperlink to log out of OneStop and be returned to the login page. Located in the top left-hand corner of the window.
	For industry stakeholders, the 'Acting as' list displays the name of the company linked with the BA ID used to log into OneStop.
Acting as: v	For consultants, a drop down list of the companies you work for displays when you click the arrow.
	Select the company you are entering pipeline data for.
	Located in the top right-hand corner of the window.
Мар	The Map button is a hyperlink. When clicked, it opens the Map Viewer application.
	Located in the top right-hand corner of the window.
	The Reports button is a hyperlink.
Reports	When clicked, it opens a new window outside of OneStop to list available pipeline reports.
	Located in the top right-hand corner of the window.
Search	The Search button is a hyperlink.

	When clicked, a new 'Search By' pop-up window displays. Users may search by application or authorization using a variety of selection criteria. Located in the top right-hand corner of the window.
Search	Click the button to execute a search to return available data.
Application	Click the Application button to select criteria by status, application ID, project name, activity ID, received date, or location.
Submission	Click the Submission button to search via submission ID, in draft or submitted form.
Authorization	Click the Authorization button to search by authorization ID, authorization type, project name, or location.
Edit	Click the Edit button to show radio buttons that allow you to select an application or submission. Once clicked, the application or amendment opens for editing.
Delete	Click the Delete button to show radio buttons that allow you to delete the selected application or submission.
<< < 1 2 3 <mark>4</mark> 5 6 7 > :	Use the Page navigation button to scroll from window to window.

Draft Draft Submitted Approved Denied	Use the drop-down list to select the search criteria for the application required. Appears on the Recent Activity Application or Submission windows.
Previous	Click the Previous button to save the data and move back to the previous window.
Save	Click the Save button to save the data and remain on the current window.
Next >	Click the Next button to save the data and move to the next window.
Validate	Click the Validate button to validate the data entered in the current window.
No Yes No	A blue button indicates the field answer is selected. A white button indicates the field answer is NOT selected.
Reset	Click the Reset button to clear the form data and return to a clean window for further criteria selection.

Attach File	Click the Attach File button to open a search dialog box, where you can navigate to select a file to attach to the application.
Consultant	Click the Consultant button on the General – Contract Information window to display consultant input data fields.
Add Row	Click the Add Row button to add a row of fields for additional data.
Copy Row	Click the Copy Row button to copy the selected pipe specification row.
Remove Selected	Click the Remove Selected button to remove the selected pipe specification row.
Show or Hide Columns	Click the Show/Hide Columns button to display a drop down list of column fields to add or remove from the selected pipe specification row.
I Accept I Decline	The I Accept/I Decline button appears when you open the map search application. Should you decline, you will not be able to open the application.
Map It!	Click the Map It button to open the map search application and view the pipeline segment on the pipeline map viewer layer.
View on Map	Click the View on Map button to open the map search application and display the location

	selected on the Alberta map.
Submit Shapefile	Click the Submit Shapefile button to upload a shapefile to OneStop and attach it to the application.
Validate Application Validate	Click the Validate Application or Validate button to have OneStop automatically validate the application and display any risk rules triggered.
Remove Selected	Click the Remove Selected button to remove the selected row from OneStop.
Accept Disclaimer	Click the Accept Disclaimer button to show the submission disclaimer declaration.
I Agree	Click the I Agree button to accept the declaration and disclaimer message.
l Disagree	When you click the I Disagree button, the application cannot be submitted.
View Disclaimer	Click the View Disclaimer button to again display the declaration and disclaimer message.
Delete Draft	Click the Delete Draft button to delete the application you are working on.
Save and Submit Application	Click the Save and Submit Application button to display the Confirm Application Submission message.

No	Click the No button to move the application back to draft status.
Yes	Click the Yes button to accept the application submitted message.
	Click the OK button to save the application submission and create a 'Submitted' status for the application you are submitting.
ОК	This saves the data from the entire application made. It moves the application out of draft mode, and submits it to the AER for review.
Close	The Close button cancels the search and closes the existing asset search form.
	Click the Search button to execute and display the results of your search criteria.
Search	Only existing licences and dispositions held under the applicant's BA ID can be linked to the application.
	The existing asset search only displays those assets that meet this criterion.
Reset	Click the Reset button to clear the form data and return a clean window for further criteria selection.
•	Click the Check button to link the asset to the application. Check may also be used to select data to be filtered, removed, or linked to another licence or amendment.

Open	Click the Open button to open the file or application selected.
Add	Click the Add button to add an additional line or installation to a licence amendment activity.
=	Click the Print button to create a PDF of the application.
Abandonment Bidirectional Flow Flow Reversal MOP Increase Other	Click the checkboxes to select the required line levelamendment types.
Attach files	Click to open Windows Explorer , which allows you to select the required files.
