## What's an enhancement?




An enhancement is any change made in the software application that improves OneStop's performance.




## What's a major fix?

A major fix is any repair made in the software application that restores OneStop's core functionality.

For all other land uses, the reclamation liability will be conditionally reduced to \$9,000.</li> <li>• Submitters will be notified if following an audit, the CARL submission is "Returned."</li> <li>• Print and publish CARL submissions available on Application Query.</li> </ul>
