Applicants must associate their submission to related Phase 1 Environmental Site Assessment (ESA). If a Phase 2 ESA has also been related, the associated Record of Site Condition (RoSC) must also be linked. New requirements to fulfil acceptable CARL submissions. 	✓ RCV to be posted in Application Query.	

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	 Submissions require a declaration from an authorized representative is. Any missed mandatory requirement or ineligible submissions must be identified during the submission confirmation assessment. Submissions for cultivated land will have reclamation liability conditionally reduced to \$5,000. For all other land uses, the reclamation liability will be conditionally reduced to \$9,000. Submitters will be notified if following an audit, the CARL submission is "Returned."
