Subsurface Order 4A

- Q1. What coal zones does Subsurface Order No. 4A (SO4A) apply to?
- A1. SO4A applies to all coal zones targeted for coalbed methane development.
- Q2. Do I still need to apply for commingling if I am outside of the area designated as Development Entity No. 1 but within the area outlined in SO4A?
- A2. Yes, you must submit a commingling application if you are outside of the development entity or do not qualify for self-declared commingling and would like to commingle production from coalbed methane (CBM) and other strata.

- Q3. Does SO4A apply to in situ coal gasification?
- A3. No, SO4A only applies to CBM production.
- Q4. Does SO4 affect water well testing?
- A4. No, SO4A does not change current baseline water well testing.
- Q5. Do CBM wells need a control well?
